

US Speedo Install Guide



Mark the position of each needle with the key off.



4. Pull the trim around the speedo off. Some may have a screw on each side.



8. Take the cluster into a clean area to start the gauge face install.



12. It will leave small dimples around the needle hubs, use a knife to remove.



1. Remove the two screws above the cluster.



5. The cluster is held in by 4 screws.

9. Remove the screws from the back of the cluster. There are a few...



13. On the back of the new guage face is a plastic liner, remove.



2. Pull on the left side vent. It is held in by clips.



6. There are 2 plug in the back of the cluster.



10. Use the needle tool to remove the needles.



14. Take the cluster back to the truck and plug in. Leave key OFF



3. Pull on the right side vent and trim. It is held in by clips.



7. You may need to use a screw driver to release the plugs.



11. Remove the stock gauge face.



15. Start to set the needles exactly as you removed them.








16. Unplug the cluster and plug back in. If the needles are set wrong, remove and start over.



17. Remove the cluster and go back in side to place the needles stop and lens on.



Correct Needle position with the key off.
